## PRESCRIBING INFORMATION:

Composition: Each capsule contains 200mg Ofloxacin. Indications: Upper and lower respiratory tract infections, ear and sinus infections, urinary and genital tract infections, gastrointestinal infections, skin and soft tissue infections, gynaecological infections. Dosage: Usual dose of Oflobiotic is two capsules daily. In severe infections it may be necessary to increase the dose from 600 to 800mg daily. The same applies to infections with complicating factors. For patients with impaired renal function the dosage of Oflobiotic should be adjusted according to the degree of impairment. Contraindications: Oflobiotic (Ofloxacin) should not be given to patients with known hypersensitivity to Ofloxacin or other quinolonecarboxylic acid derivatives. Epileptics, children or adolescents in the growth phase, in pregnant or lactating women. Side effects: Ofloxacin is well tolerated after oral administration. Most often reported side effect are gastric discomfort, nausea, anorexia, diarrhoea and skin reactions. Precautions: A very high precentage of medicine is excreted in urine so the dosage should be reduced accordingly in the patients with renal insufficiency. Presentation: Capsules pack of 10's in blister.
