Prescribing information: Indications: Zoxicillin is indicated in a wide range of infections caused by susceptible organisms lower respiratory tract infections, Upper respiratory tract infections, Urinary tract infections, Severe systemic infections, Skin & soft tissue infections, Venereal Infections, Pelvic infections, Oral prophylaxis of Endocarditis/Dental Infections. Dosage: I.M. 250-500mg every 8 hours or more frequently if necessary I.V. 500mg- 1g every 4-6 hours. Children: 125mg every 8 hours, increasing to 250mg for more severe infections, Zoxicillin drops are recommended for children under 6 months of age, based on body weight 35-100mg/kg/day. **Precautions**: Reduced dosage is required in patient with impaired renal function. **Contraindications**: Penicillin hypersensitivity. **Side** effects: Diarrhoea Indigestion or an occasional rash, either urticarial, which suggests penicillin hypersensitivity or erythematous.
